

CRA in phases: manageable & audit-ready

The **Cyber Resilience Act (CRA)** is not just a compliance exercise. It is also a lever for improving your product and your processes. This roadmap puts the required steps into an actionable sequence.

1 ANALYSIS OF THE CURRENT STATE

- Build a clean view of the product list and CRA scope
- Clarify ownership and responsibilities for each product
- Establish a reliable baseline of the current situation

2 PRODUCT CATEGORIZATION & COMPLIANCE STRATEGY

- Classify products (standard / class I / class II)
- Define the applicable conformity path and decision logic
- Identify relevant regulations and notified bodies

3 GAP ANALYSIS & ACTION PLAN

- Compare current state vs. target state (top gaps, risks, priorities)
- Derive measures with roadmap and clear responsibilities

4 IMPLEMENTATION (PROCESSES & TOOLS)

- Set up vulnerability, reporting, and update processes
- Define internal controls
- Put the right tooling, enablement, and training in place

5 DOCUMENTATION & SBOM

- Structure technical documentation and supporting evidence
- Establish SBOM creation as an ongoing process
- Build documentation readiness early

6 CE MARKING & DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

- Prepare conformity documentation on a solid basis
- Set up the declaration and supporting evidence properly
- Ensure audit-ready filing and document management

7 LIVE OPERATION & HYPERCARE

- Establish monitoring, patch/update delivery, and vulnerability review
- Anchor internal audits and continuous improvement
- Do not just achieve CRA compliance, but make it work in daily operations

Critical deadlines for CRA implementation

→ **June 11, 2026**
Notification of conformity assessment bodies

→ **September 11, 2026**
Reporting obligations for vulnerabilities / incidents (Art. 14)

→ **December 11, 2027**
Full application of all requirements
